

We're so glad to see you in person!

Here are some things you should know about our return to in-person worship times.

1) **Masks are required during the 8:00 service.** We ask that everyone in attendance wears a mask for the entire service, with the exception of those who are on stage using a microphone.

2) **Masks are optional during the 9:30 service.** We will not require that masks be worn; each person in attendance is given the freedom to decide for themselves whether they will wear a mask or not.

3) **Please practice social distancing.** We've arranged the chairs in our auditorium so that there is a significant distance between each row. Please leave at least 2 empty chairs between you/your family and the next person or group.

4) **For the time-being, the two services will include identical content.** We will use a blend of traditional and contemporary music. The instruments used during the music may vary from service to service, but all other elements of our worship times will be identical. The hope is to return to our stylistically different services soon, but we want to take the time to do it safely and in a way that meets the needs of our entire church body.

5) **Kids Crossing will continue to be offered online for at least the next couple of weeks.** We will do our best to have elements in our worship times that actively engage the children, and then Kids Crossing programming will be available after the 9:30 service, via our normal live stream options.

6) **Speaking of Live Stream...** Our 9:30 service will continue to be broadcast via our live stream on a permanent basis.
